## Hobbes (1588-1679)

Leviathan (1651)

With no government, human nature will bring us into severe conflict with one another.

Humans will be forced into conflict because of the following factors:

- 1. Natural scarcity of goods
- 2. All have equal ability to kill or be killed
- 3. We will need to gain resources
- 4. We need to protect ourselves
- 5. We need to establish a particular reputation

Individual rationality (working in immediate short term interest) will clash with collective rationality (what's in everybody's interest)

## Hobbes' solution

A powerful sovereign who will severely punish those who break the law. It will then be in our self interest to obey the law.

Individual rationality will coincide with collective rationality
