Kierkegaard (1813-1855)

- There is no logical way to prove God's existence
- Christianity is full of contradictions
- We must, therefore, make a "leap to faith". We must **jettison reason** and simply embrace the idea of God.

Problems

- 1. If we reject reason, we have no criteria with which we can make choices. How can *any* choice ever be justified?
- 2. Isn't reason the one thing that makes us truly human? By rejecting reason are we rejecting our very essence?
